



## VETERANS PRO BONO LEGAL SERVICES CLINIC AT THE BATTERY ATLANTA VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

The Warrior Alliance (TWA), a Georgia-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, is hosting a Veteran Pro Bono Legal Clinic on Wednesday, Nov 10, 2021 at The Battery Atlanta in celebration of Veterans Day. The event will attract hundreds of veterans, military families, and National Guard/Reservists seeking pro bono assistance with legal issues as they work through the challenges of transition from military service.

TWA's mission is to help Warriors and their families achieve a fulfilling civilian life by promoting collaboration between the organizations that can support them. The recent partnership with the Atlanta Braves, through the Atlanta Braves Foundation, supports TWA's goal for improving veteran quality of life by establishing a new veteran facility, called "The Warrior Alliance Home Base" at The Battery Atlanta. This partnership and world-class sports and entertainment venue provides a platform for TWA to serve more veterans across the state of Georgia.

The coalition of legal service providers participating in the clinic include the Atlanta Volunteer Lawyers Foundation, Legal Aid Atlanta, State Bar of Georgia, Georgia Legal Services Program, Emory Law Volunteer Clinic for Veterans, and University of Georgia School of Law. We are seeking volunteers for both pro bono attorney and paralegal assistance for the event.

**Pro Bono Attorneys-** provide legal consultations and advice to veterans that are pre-screened and assessed for case documentation and military status. Attorney requirements include:

- Legal expertise in Veteran Benefits, Discharge Upgrade, Landlord-Tenant, Mortgage, Wills and Estate Planning, Debt Collection and Bankruptcy, and Family Law;
- Commitment of 3 hours for either 9am-noon or 1pm-4pm;
- Up to 50 onsite/ 25 remote for 9am-12pm and 50 onsite/25 remote for 1pm-4pm;
- Consultations to be scheduled by Paralegal Volunteers in 45 minute increments.

**Paralegals-** provide review of veteran intake form, case assessment, and pro bono requirement qualification, in addition to collecting case documentation and scheduling of veterans with the proper attorney referral. Paralegal requirements include:

- 10-20 volunteers for pre-clinic veteran intake, assessment, and schedulings beginning October 25, 2021 through November 10, 2021;
- 8 volunteers to be onsite the day of the event for veteran intake, assessment, and scheduling.
